



ANGOLA ADVENTURE

15 DAYS | TANZANIA, ZAMBIA, DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO, ANGOLA | FROM AU\$18,300 PP

An east-west African adventure uniting the Atlantic and Indian Oceans. This new 15-day expedition across Tanzania, Zambia, the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Angola. It will be the first time in history that a passenger train will travel the famous east-to-west copper trail on this route. This inaugural voyage will include a game visit in the Selous Reserve, a fly-in two-night safari in the South Luangwa National Park (Zambia), a city tour of Lubumbashi (DRC) and short walking tours in Lobito detailing Angola's recent history. The voyage is available in reverse departing from Lobito (Angola) on 2 August 2019.

Day	Dar es Salaam → Lobito (available in reverse)
1	The Pride of Africa departs Dar es Salaam and travels the TAZARA line. Lunch is served in the dining cars as the train travels the fertile lands of Tanzania towards the Selous Game Reserve.
2	Game visit in the Selous Game Reserve, the largest in Africa at 55 000km ² (time permitting). Lunch is served in the dining cars as the train passes the Udzungwa Mountains.
3	The train ascends the escarpment negotiating the dramatic switchbacks, viaducts and tunnels. Arrive at Makambako and enjoy a stroll through the town (time permitting). Lunch is served in the dining cars as the train passes Baobab forests.
4	The train travels in a southwesterly direction across Zambia. Disembark at Kasama for an excursion to Chisimba Falls.
5	Disembark and transfer to Mpika Airport for a chartered flight to the South Luangwa National Park. Transfer to Mfuwe Game Lodge. Enjoy lunch on arrival. Afternoon game drive in the Luangwa Valley.
6	Early morning game drive (approximately 3 hours). Brunch is served at the lodge. Afternoon at leisure. High tea and game drive (approximately 3 hours).

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| 7 | Early morning game drive (approximately 2 hours). Transfer to Mfuwe Airport for the chartered flight to Ndola, Zambia. On arrival, transfer to Ndola Station to rejoin the train. Lunch is served in the dining cars as the train travels towards Misundu. Dinner is served in the dining cars as the train travels through Kabemba. |
| 8 | Enjoy a city tour of Lubumbashi. The train passes Luishia, an old open-pit copper and cobalt mine. Dinner is served in the dining cars as the train travels through Mutaka. |
| 9 | Enjoy a visit to a copper mine in an area that holds one of the world's largest known copper and cobalt resources. Afternoon lecture in the lounge car. |
| 10 | Lunch is served in the dining cars as the train passes Kasaji en route to Malonga. Dinner is served in the dining cars. Overnight Dilolo on the DRC/Angola Border. |
| 11 | Enjoy a walking tour of Luau, the start of the Benguela line. Tea is served as the train travels alongside the Kasai River. As the train passes the villages of Cassai and Cameia there is sometimes an opportunity to see the local fisherman at work. |
| 12 | Enjoy a walking tour of Luena to learn more about the recent history of Angola. Depart for Tchicala Tcholohanga. Afternoon lecture in the lounge car. |
| 13 | Enjoy a stroll through the town of Kuito, built in the historical heart of the Ovimbundu kingdom. Depart for Huambo. Afternoon lecture in the lounge car. |
| 14 | Enjoy a walking tour of Huambo, the second largest city in Angola and one of the old kingdoms on the central plateau. Depart for Lépi. Afternoon lecture in the lounge car. |
| 15 | Arrive at journey's end, Lobito Station, Benguela Province, Angola. |
