Thomas Wines: Flagship Vertical Tasting

Andrew Thomas has twice won him the Winemaker of the Year title at the Hunter Valley Wine Awards and his signature single vineyard wines encapsulate his minimum-intervention winemaking approach.

At this private cellar door tasting, the in-house sommelier will take you take you through tastings of the winery's two flagship wines – the Braemore Semillon and the KISS Shiraz.

The 2016 benchmark Hunter Shiraz was awarded a gold medal on its first showing and represents Thomas' style to a tee – Keep It Simple Stupid (KISS).

Margan Family: Margan Tasting Experience

Twenty years ago, Lisa and Andrew Margan bought an empty paddock in the Broke Fordwich area of the Hunter Valley and created one of the most celebrated food and wine experiences in the region.

The Margan Tasting Experience includes a tour of the vineyard and winery, tastings of signature blends, and a tour of the one-acre 'kitchen garden', that includes an orchard, free-range chickens, bee hives and countless herbs and vegetables.

Having pioneered the 'agri-dining' concept in the Hunter Valley, you will finish your visit with a three-course lunch in the award-winning, one-hatted restaurant.

McLeish Estate: Wines of Distinction Private Tasting

Australia's most awarded boutique winery, McLeish Estate was established more than 30 years ago in Pokolbin by Robert and Maryanne McLeish. In 2016 McLeish Wines received the trophy for World's Best Semillon at the London International Wine Challenge and Australia's White Wine of the Year in 2014.

This tasting will give you access to these award-winning wines and guides you through the Hunter Valley's benchmark varietals.

The tasting format also provides vertical tastings showcasing the high pedigree of the McLeish single vineyard, and tasting notes and recipes are provided to take home.

Gundog Estate: Wine Tasting

Winner of the 2018 Gourmet Traveller WINE Magazine Best Small Cellar Door, a tasting at this boutique winery takes place in the historic Pokolbin Schoolhouse.

Wine bottles and gourmet food products line the walls as you explore four styles of current vintage Hunter Semillon and two Hunter Shiraz, before enjoying six single-vineyard Semillon and Shiraz from 2014 (arguably the best ever Hunter vintage).

If you're lucky you will get to meet Karl Marx, the winery's resident cocker spaniel and failed gundog who inspired the estate's name and label.

Keith Tulloch: Winemakers Table Tasting

This one-of-a-kind tasting is hosted in the barrel hall and winery of this famed estate.

A dedicated member of staff will take you through the most premium current releases and you can taste upcoming wines from the tank or barrel.

You will have the opportunity to meet with fourth-generation Chief Winemaker Keith Tulloch, or one of the winery team, to ask in-depth questions about how the wines are made and the Tulloch philosophy.

Brokenwood: Tour and Shiraz Masterclass

James Halliday started his wine journey at Brokenwood in 1970 when he and two friends bought a 10-acre block that was destined to be a cricket ground and instead created a hobby wine farm that has turned into one of Australia's most reputable labels.

The afternoon begins with a guided tour of the winery production area and a walk through the iconic Graveyard Vineyard before tasting upcoming wines straight from the barrel in the Barrel Hall.

Then, at the home of the exceptional Graveyard Vineyard Shiraz, you will learn the secrets of the perfect pick, winemaking methods and cellaring potential of this well-loved variety in your Shiraz masterclass.
