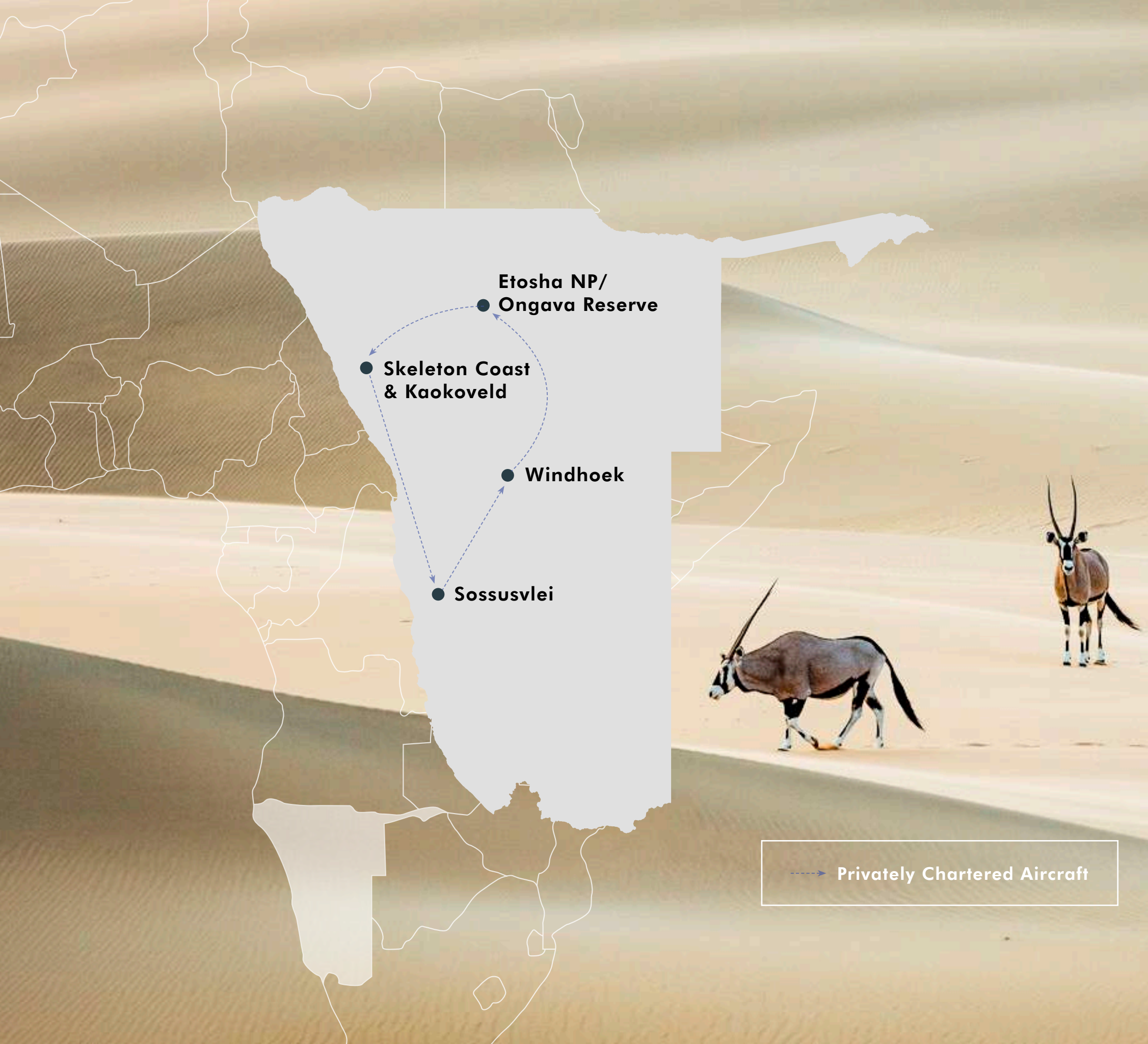

YOUR JOURNEY

Day 1

Arrive Namibia

SUNDAY 1 MARCH

Arrive into the Namibian capital, Windhoek, where you'll be met and driven to the luxurious Olive Exclusive hotel. Walk into your spacious suite, with its own lounge and fireplace, and unwind after your flight. This evening join your host, Andrea Francolini, and fellow travellers for dinner at your hotel. *(Lunch at own expense.)*

Day 2

Little Ongava & Etosha NP

MONDAY 2 MARCH

Board your private aircraft for a short flight to Little Ongava Tented Camp, within a private reserve and close to Etosha National Park.

This afternoon have your cameras ready as you embark on your first game drive. Keep an eye out for the resident rhino population and the more elusive lion as you explore the uncrowded area within the private Ongava Reserve.

This evening come together for our first dinner in the African bush.



Days 3+4

Little Ongava & Etosha NP

TUESDAY 3 & WEDNESDAY 4 MARCH

It's worth taking your camera to breakfast at Ongava, dining alfresco overlooking the waterhole you might catch a glimpse of animals as they come for their morning drink.

There are plenty of options over the next two days. Take a guided walking safari. Head out on a 4WD adventure with your guide to Etosha National Park, which contains some of Africa's best opportunities for game viewing. Take a dip in your private plunge pool - every suite has one.

Leave time for staking out your place at one of the lodge's photographic hides, patiently waiting for that perfect shot. And one evening we recommend taking a night time 4WD safari, watching out for the stealthy cats stalking unsuspecting prey.

Indulge with a pre dinner cocktail before a wonderful dinner upon the open deck at Little Ongava. All meals and drinks are included – and the service is impeccable.

Day 5

Skeleton Coast & Kaokoveld

THURSDAY 5 MARCH

Namibia is full of moody, desolate landscapes, void of human activity – none more so than the remote Kaokoveld region, which you reach today by private plane. Your home for the next three nights is the remote and luxurious Hoanib Skeleton Coast Camp.

Arrive in time for lunch overlooking the alluring arid desert landscapes. Take a refreshing dip in the pool before you choose from an afternoon or evening game drive, in search of the surprisingly plentiful desert adapted wildlife including elephant, giraffe, lion and brown hyena.

As on every other day, your photographic host, Andrea, is on hand to provide expert tips.



Days 6+7

Skeleton Coast & Kaokoveld

FRIDAY 6 & SATURDAY 7 MARCH

Over the next two days you'll have ample opportunities to explore the local area including dry river beds and intriguing landscapes through guided walks and 4WD safari expeditions. Encounter the animals of this isolated region and marvel at their ability to adapt to desert life.

On one of the days you will have the opportunity to take a full day trip to the Skeleton Coast, filled with the noise of Cape fur seals and countless shipwrecks. Stroll along the beach to photograph the fur seal spectacle and capture with your lens the remains of the ships.

As the only people at this luxury tented camp your desert experience will be intimate.

Day 8

Sossusvlei

SUNDAY 8 MARCH

Another flight by private aircraft allows you the opportunity to capture the diverse landscapes below. And there are few more iconic or remarkable landscapes than the ochre red dunes of the Namib Desert.

Landing directly on the airstrip of our lodge means no time is wasted in getting out to explore the area – or even just taking time to unwind in luxury at the recently reopened Sossusvlei Desert Lodge.

Nestled into the Namib Desert the lodge offers complete serenity and seclusion overlooking the awe inspiring dunes. This is a place to reconnect with nature, completely removed from the hustle and bustle of regular life.

An extraordinary clarity of light lends itself to unusual photographic opportunities and a resident astronomer staffs the lodge's world class observatory.

Before dinner enjoy pre dinner drinks around the waterhole, watching the animals come for their own nightcap.



Day 9

Sossusvlei

MONDAY 9 MARCH

A world of vast spaces, boundless horizons and rugged mountains make this area one of Africa's most compelling landscapes.

Your choices today seem as endless as the undulating dunes themselves. Of course a 4WD trip into the dunes is a must but what about a quad bike excursion (conditions permitting)? Join a guide for a walk to view the San rock paintings. For a truly remarkable view, take to the skies in a hot air balloon (additional cost). Or head out for one final game drive.

This evening we come together for a special farewell dinner. Don't forget to exchange email addresses with newfound friends, there's bound to be a lot of photo sharing when you return home

Day 10

Depart Namibia

TUESDAY 10 MARCH

Meals at Sossusvlei Desert Lodge are always a highlight, whether it's the fine cuisine or the maître d' finding you a secluded magical location. You'll have one more chance to savour the flavours over breakfast before you transfer via private aircraft to Windhoek airport and your connecting onward flights. Return home or speak to us about options to continue your Africa adventure.

Please note – the itinerary is a guide only, daily activities may change according to your desires or local operation needs. Safari drives are expeditionary in nature and, while highly likely, wildlife sightings are not guaranteed.



What you'll need:

- » A DSLR Camera with lens/lenses
- » Spare batteries, there will be a long days with plenty of shooting.
- » A tripod
- » Remote shutter release
- » Lens filters (if you have them)
- » Decent walking shoes
- » Loose fitting clothing and wet weather gear

- » Endless wildlife photographic opportunities
- » Extraordinary scenery & diverse topography
- » Remote desert landscapes
- » Stunning red sand dunes of Sossusvlei
- » Salt pans at Etosha NP
- » Night skies that stretch forever including Sossusvlei's 'Dark Sky Reserve'
- » Sublime sunsets across the plains
- » Aerial photography aboard the private planes
