#### Arrive Namibia SUNDAY 1 MARCH

This afternoon have your cameras ready as you embark on your first game drive. Keep an eye out for the resident rhino population and the more elusive lion as you explore the uncrowded area within the private Ongava Reserve.

This evening come together for our first dinner in the African bush.



#### Days 3+4

#### Etosha N.P. & Ongava Reserve TUESDAY 3 & WEDNESDAY 4 MARCH

There are plenty of options over the next two days. Take a guided walking safari. Head out on a 4WD adventure with your guide to Etosha National Park, which contains some of Africa's best opportunities for game viewing.

Leave time for staking out your place at one of the lodge's photographic hides, patiently waiting for that perfect shot. And one evening we recommend taking a night time 4WD safari, watching out for the stealthy cats stalking unsuspecting prey.

Indulge with a pre dinner cocktail before a wonderful dinner upon the open deck at Ongava. All meals and drinks are included – and the service is impeccable.


#### Skeleton Coast & Kaokoveld THURSDAY 5 MARCH

FRIDAY 6 & SATURDAY 7 MARCH

This evening we come together for a special farewell dinner. Don't forget to exchange email addresses with newfound friends, there's bound to be a lot of photo sharing when you return home.




#### **Depart Namibia** TUESDAY 10 MARCH


